#### GIRLS...

As a 3G camper, you'll meet other girls who love God and love to have fun! Our counselors are all College of Saint Benedict (CSB) students who volunteer their time and come back year after year—as do our campers.

Campers live in the CSB residence halls and eat their meals at the Gorecki Center. There are two girls to each room. You can choose your own roommate on the registration form if you know another camper. There will be one adult counselor for every six to eight girls.
